## Cinching Wrist Cuff Installation and Usage Instructions

## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- Wrist strap end should only be used on the wrist.
- Carabiner end should be attached to a suitable attachment point (options sold separately).
- Tool attachment points should be free of sharp edges and should always have fully closed loops.
- If duct tape is required, the hook and loop has lost its grip and lanyard should be discarded.
- Do not intentionally suspend a tool by its lanyard.
- Remove and replace if:
  - there is any evidence of wear.
  - tether experiences a drop.
  - any doubt to product's integrity.
